



**The information below pertains to all students in grades 7-12 during the 2017-2018 school year who will participate in either Athletics, Band, Drill Team, Cheer, or ROTC**

The Pasadena ISD Athletic Department would like to thank you for taking the time to complete the UIL and Pasadena ISD required forms to participate in the athletic program, Band, Drill Team, Cheer or ROTC. All students athletes 7 – 12<sup>th</sup> grade are required to fill out and submit these forms online prior to each school year.

Pasadena ISD and the UIL require the parent/legal guardian and student to complete the participations forms annually. Parents and students are required to read and submit the UIL forms as they pertain to them. This year's paperwork will be completed online to make the process convenient for all families. The only required form that cannot be done electronically is the annual physical and medical history. Students will be handed a physical form from their respective school athletic trainer, coach, or sponsor to be used when receiving their medical examination. **NO OTHER** Physical Examination form can be accepted per the UIL. **A new physical exam must be given prior to each calendar school year.**

All **required participation forms** must be completed in their **entirety** and returned to the athlete's coach or athletic trainer before a student participates in **any** try-out, practice, athletic class, open gym, open weight room or athletic competition.

This is the **FIRST** year we've gone to online forms. We apologize that some of you have already filled out the paperwork but are now required to complete some of the same forms online. In the future, everything except the physical form will be done online.

We've been doing this for two years at the high school level. Here are some things we've learned:

- \* EVERY box needs to be filled in or the system won't let you Submit.
- \*There's a place to fill out the Online Forms AND the Emergency Card. Be sure and do both.
- \*You can fill out these online forms WITHOUT creating an account.
